## **Facts About HIV/AIDS**

- 1.2 million Americans are living with HIV and 1 in 8 is unaware of his/her infection.
- There are more than 11,000 people living with HIV/AIDS in Indiana.
- Approximately 500 new cases of HIV and AIDS are reported in Indiana *every year*.
- The majority of those living with HIV/AIDS in Indiana are between 40–49 years of age. However, those aged 25–29 make up the majority of new HIV diagnoses.
- HIV disproportionately affects black males more than their white counterparts.
- Nearly half of the new diagnoses can be found in the MSM risk category, and new cases among males outnumber females by more than 5 to 1.
- Scott County, Indiana continues to shine the national spotlight on HIV as a major public health issue. As of August 2016, 205 Scott County residents were HIV+.
